So if you haven't been around for a while, come back and see how the social aspects of the Lodge are taking shape again.

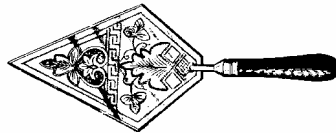

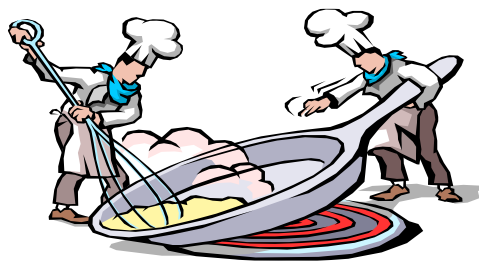
