ABOUT THE COVER

King Solomon's Temple

The Temple of Solomon has played a most important part in Freemasonry. Other Freemasons believe we must receive the myths and legends that connect it with the Temple, not indeed as historic facts, but as allegories; not as events that have really transpired, but as symbols; and must accept these allegories and these symbols for what their inventors really meant that they should be-the foundation of a Science of morality.

Be it fact or a hybrid of actual events and speculation; the Masonic history of King Solomon's Temple and Freemasonry has proved itself as one of the most beneficial systems of establishing morality in our society. Happy March, ladies!

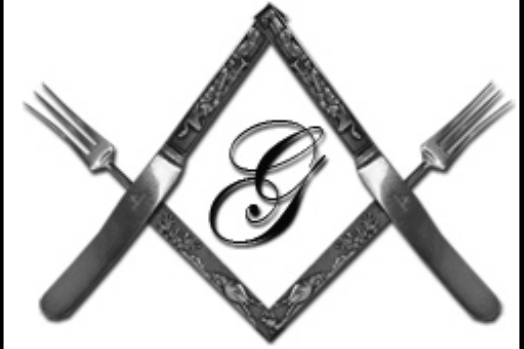
