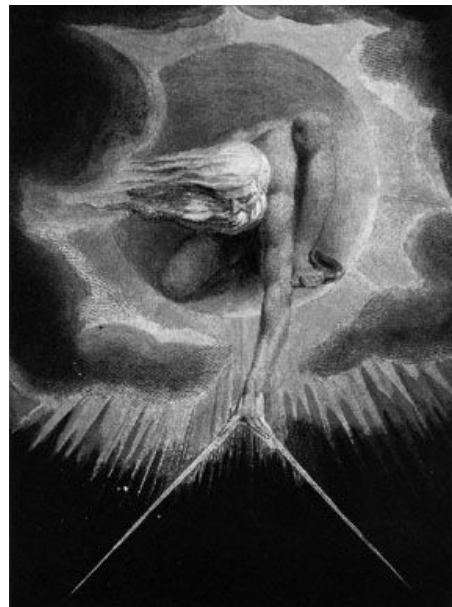

The title "Ancient of Days" has been used as a source of inspiration in art and music, denoting the creator's aspects of eternity combined with perfection.

This work of art depicts God circumscribing to create the universe with a pair of compasses...many believe its inspiration is Masonic.

Ancient of Days is a name for God in Aramaic (*Atik Yomin*); in the Greek Septuagint: (*Palaios Hemeron*); and in the Vulgate: (*Antiquus Dierum*).

He took the golden compasses, prepared in God's eternal store, to circumscribe this universe, and all created things:

One foot he centered, and the other turned round through the vast profundity obscure;

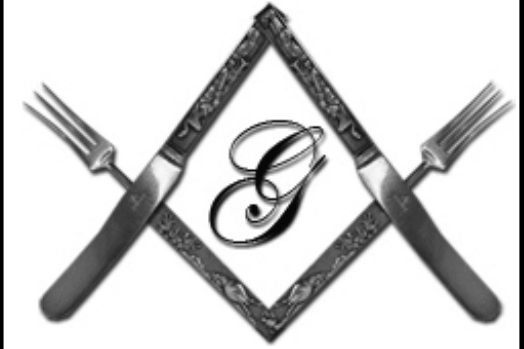
