## ABOUT THE COVER

### The Sprig of Acacia

The acacia is a thorny plant, with red and white flowers, that abounds in the Middle East.

Both Jews and Egyptians believed that because of its hardness, its evergreen nature, and its durability, it signified immortality. Hebrew people used to plant a sprig of acacia at the head of a grave to mark the location of the grave and to show their belief in immortality.

Because of its evergreen nature, they believed it to be an emblem of both immortality and innocence.

In Egypt, acacia also symbolized rebirth and was an emblem of the goddess Neith; the deceased received her divine power by means of the mummy's wrappings, for the bandages and shrouds were considered gifts of Neith, who was regarded as the patroness of weaving.

It is believed that the acacia was used to construct most of the furniture and the tabernacle in the Temple.

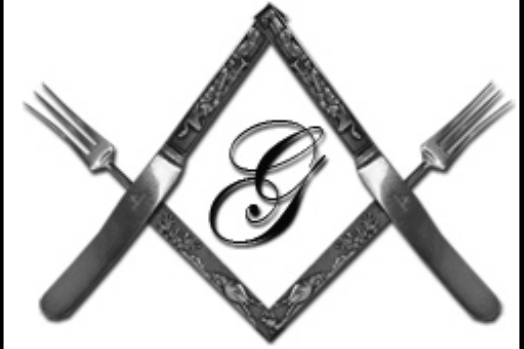
